Dear Guests of Rideau View,

As with many private clubs, the topic of dress has been a popular topic at Rideau View. Although we recognize that the game of golf has been steeped in tradition, we also believe it is important to understand how general lifestyles and dress continue to change over time. Current styles and trends are leaning more towards fashion and comfort. This is evident on both the PGA and LPGA TOURS.

In view of the above, we have simplified the on-course dress code and developed a more relaxed dress code for the clubhouse.

Simply stated, attire on and off the golf course should be of acceptable, smart casual style.

For purposes of clarity, **ACCEPTABLE** attire on the golf course includes:

- Short or long sleeve golf shirt with collar;
- Golf shirts may be worn untucked, if they have a finished hem that is the same length front and back;
- Sleeveless golf shirt with collar (women only);
- Collarless golf shirt with sleeves (women only);
- Short or long sleeve mock neck shirts;
- Regular length golf slacks;
- Golf shorts of an appropriate length;
- Cargo shorts and cargo pants;
- Golf skirts of an appropriate length;
- Sockettes with shorts or skirts.

Smart casual and clean denim are acceptable in all areas of the Clubhouse.

Golf caps can be worn on the lower and upper patios and the pub. As a general rule, golf caps are not to be worn in the main dining room, unless expressly allowed by league or event organizers.

It is important to note that in relaxing the dress code, we trust that members and guests will not stretch the meaning of *casual* but, rather, embrace the spirit of our intent.
